FRONT

- >right eye lower than the left eye: just like the Mona Lisa
- Same enigmatic "smile" as the Mona Lisa
- "10" shingles in a circular (feminine) pattern for the 10th letter of the alphabet "J" for Josephine
- "2" shingles facing forward for the 2nd letter of the alphabet "B" for Bonaparte
- "Fleur-de-lis" design, a symbol of French Monarchy, in the silver base



LEFT SIDE

- "3" shingles for the third Tarot card: "EMPRESS"
- All shingles: "Empress Josephine Bonaparte"
- "3" shingles followed by "4" sapphires and then by "6" sapphires: "Empress" - "Emperor" - "Lovers"
- 10" sapphires in a part-circle pattern: "Wheel of Fate" in the Tarot, and depicted as below a sphinx, as here
- "4" emeralds: "Emperor" (green is Napoleon's favorite color)
- "2" pearls (one on each side): "Wisdom" in the Tarot—Pearls of Wisdom---under the emeralds, Napoleon's foundation
- 21" rubies in each panel with a "blank" spot for a ruby in the left panel: "21 and a blank": Tarot: 21 cards and a blank card; THE KEY TO UNLOCKING THE CODE
- > rear attachment for holding a lock of Josephine's hair



RIGHT SIDE

> "21" rubies in all four panels

- Ieft panel has the date coded within: "8" rows (instead of seven) for the 8th month: August; "15" rubies before a blank, flat area, for "August 15" (Napoleon's birthday); and a "blank" spot followed by two rubies for "02" or "1802"; August 15, 1802 was the celebration of Napoleon's 33rd birthday (33rd Degree is the highest level of the Masonic Order) and his Lifetime appointment as Ruler of France
- there are 114 precious stones in the Talisman + the quartz crystal sphinx: "1-14-1" for Napoleon Bonaparte---same exact pattern of coding as used to identify Josephine



WINGS

The "wings" spread out to reveal the secret "Red Cross"---the symbol of the secret society The Rosicrucians of which Napoleon was a member

In his classic book, **French Jewelry** of the Nineteenth Century referring to jewelry from Napoleon's Consulate and Empire periods he states:






"Visual source material is rare; nearly all the important jewels of the period have been dispersed, broken up or melted down.


Even the Crown Jewels have not survived and almost without exception they have been remounted."

Napoleon's Rosicrucian Medal

Stolen from the Briars Museum in Australia, and never recovered. The only other medal in existence known to have belonged to Napoleon.



The exact same coding was used by Napoleon on both the Rosicrucian Medal and the Talisman.





Note: Neither of these appraisers knew of the other's valuation!

"It's all Just a Coincidence"

As a demonstration, the mathematical equivalent of the 27 coding factors being a coincidence would be the following nickel test:

- Make a blind, random selection from 25 nickels; you must select the only 2004-dated nickel to continue.
- Flip the nickel on a level, hard surface, the nickel must land on its edge to continue.
- The nickel must be oriented North-South to within one degree to continue.
- The nickel must be within one degree of perfectly vertical to continue.
- Now, if the head is pointing East and not West, you have achieved the same proven odds as coincidence accounting for the Talisman decoding factors.
- And remember, you only get one try.

Simple math a third grader can do:

1/6000 (coin flip data from a NASA study) X 1/25 (nickels in jar) X 1/360 (coin perfectly North/South) X 1/360 (coin perfectly vertical) X 1/2 (coin facing East, not West) = 1/44,000,000,000,000.
